Our philosophy:
Our educational programs are based on an interdisciplinary curriculum that promotes sustainable living practices and responsible stewardship.

We focus on three areas of knowledge:

- Ecological Literacy: We explore how the natural world works and our place in it, by studying the web of life, the cycles of nature and the flow of energy through our environment.
- Healthy Living: This means knowing what is good for our bodies, minds and spirits. We study sustainable food systems and how to make responsible lifestyle choices that support healthy families, communities and societies.
- Local History: We study the natural and cultural history of our home place. We investigate nature in our immediate surroundings and explore the cultural context of the community in which we live.
